Holi and Vaisakhi Assembly

An assembly about two important festivals was presented to all year groups. Holi which takes place on 24th March 2024 is celebrated by people who belong to the Hindu Dharmic religion.

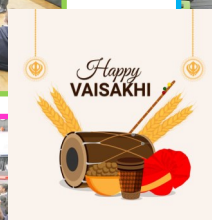
It marks the start of Spring and is known as the festival of colour. Hindu people celebrate this day by playing with colours, throwing water balloons at each other, exchanging stories and singing and dancing. Holi symbolises good over evil. Children in year one shared what they do during Holi.

Vaisakhi is a spring festival that is celebrated by Sikh people.

This year it is on 13th April. It celebrates the founding of the Sikh community, the Khalsaa.

The children learnt about Guru Gobind Singh and the 5 Panj Pyare (the 5 beloved ones). Sikh people celebrate by going to the Gurdwara to listen to prayers and hymns, parading through the streets and exchanging gifts.

At the end of assembly, Key Stage 2 students sang Holi and Vaisakhi songs.
