CONTEXT	<p>Recount based on Invisible dog</p> <p>Missing dog poster (description)</p> <p>Recount based on 'something fishy' or 'the present' short film.</p> <p>Location description based on geography topic of London</p> <p>Write a letter to Janie as Arfy the dog.</p>	<p>Postcard, using Great Fire of London as a theme.</p> <p>Instructions linked to the explanation text.</p> <p>Start as instruction and develop into explanation.</p>	<p>Explanation linked to science – how /why to stay clean and healthy.</p> <p>Description of different spiders using Why We Should Be Kinder To Spiders as a stimulus.</p> <p>Report on spiders.</p>	<p>Letter of persuasion to Mr Bond.</p> <p>Location description, persuading visitors to go there.</p> <p>Invitation to the same place or use a different stimulus.</p>	<p>Newspaper report based on strange happenings in local farm.</p> <p>Review a short video or a book.</p> <p>Comparison based on animals (see Lions and Tigers text).</p>	<p>Use Charlotte's Web as stimulus.
